“Teaching both basketball and Christian principles to kids has long been my passion. With over 25 years of basketball camp experience, I have borrowed from the best and have developed a way of teaching kids the art of learning, not only the basics of the game, but I stress teaching the details it takes to be successful in the up-tempo, outside shooting, and physical game that basketball has developed into today. Player development is the key to maintaining success over an extended period of time.”

Coach Bostwick has coached championship teams both at the high school and collegiate level. His programs have won two NAIA National Championship in the past five seasons. His record at OWU is an amazing 93-15. His teams rank in the top 5 annually in outside shooting, while having a reputation of overachieving in all areas of the game.

“Today’s game has changed, all five players on the floor need to learn how to shoot, handle the basketball, and play facing the basket. At the same time learning to enjoy the physical part of posting, defending and rebounding is a must as well.”

At the collegiate level he has coached nine NAIA All-Americans including Brandon Cole and Steve Briggs, who rank No. 1 and No. 4 All-Time in three-point shooting in the history of college basketball. For eight straight seasons one of his players have ranked at or near the top in three-point shooting.

“God has blessed me with the opportunity to coach some great players over the years. They have taught me as much as I was able to teach them. I look forward to sharing that knowledge and the Christian principles that can help young athletes become successful both on and off the floor.”

DAY & BOARDING CAMPS

These camps are for boys and girls ages 8 to 16.

May 31—JUNE 2 DAY CAMP ONLY

Emphasis

SHOOTING—Details of developing a better shot such as footwork, quicker release, and learning the keys needed to be a great shooter. Using your shot to set up one-on one skills.

LITTLE DRIBBLERS CAMP - JUNE 11-12

This camp is for kids ages 5-10. Basketball becomes fun when you can dribble, we make dribbling come to life for kids by teaching fun drills and playing all sorts dribbling games. Camp is from 9 am to Noon each day.

DIAPER DANDY CAMP - JULY 16-17

This camp is for kids ages 4 to 8 years old. It is a unique opportunity for little kids to get hooked on basketball. Camp will run from 9 a.m. to noon each day. By lowering the goals and breaking them into three groups—Small, Smaller & Smallest, we are able to make this an enjoyable experience for little kids as they learn the basics of dribbling and shooting. We have to have a few contests for the older kids but the emphasis is on participation and everyone leaving camp with a fun positive experience. It has been a huge hit and is a great way to get your child hooked on the game of basketball
