## Template for writing an Annotated Bibliography

An annotated bibliography does contain a title page, but does not include a reference page as the citation is at the top of the paper. This is basically a two paragraph paper that incorporates level headings. First person should not be used.

## **EXAMPLE FORMAT:**

Parkman, C. (2003). Faith and healing. *The Case Manager*, 14(1), 33-36. (Citation here)

**Summary** (bolded, flush left on 1" margin)

**Application** (bolded, flush left on 1" margin)

As a nurse practicing in an acute care setting, it is important to recognize .....(Describe how it applies to nursing). This should be a full paragraph.
