Re: Oklahoma Wesleyan University Operating in Oklahoma

Oklahoma Wesleyan University (OKWU) complies with 70 O.S. §4103 and may operate as a degree granting institution in Oklahoma based on its participation in the Oklahoma Tuition Equalization Grant (OTEG) program. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE) do not require authorization of specific sites within Oklahoma for private institutions participating in OTEG; therefore, all of OKWU's sites located in Oklahoma are in compliance with OSRHE's *Institutional Accreditation and State Authorization* policy.

As a private institution, OKWU is not required to seek approval or exemption from the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to offer: 1) courses at specific sites or 2) individual academic programs.
