Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College Educational Partnership and Articulation Agreement

Introduction. Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College are both committed to providing high-quality educational programs to their respective constituencies. Because they have different, but complementary missions, Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College, are well suited to establish a partnership for the benefit of the students they serve.

Partnership Agreement. Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College agree to work together as active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students. Both institutions commit themselves to making the transition between the two institutions as seamless as possible. This agreement provides a framework within which articulation on all levels can be supported and developed. In particular, this agreement will facilitate a student's ability to transfer from Rhema Bible Training College into either an associate-awarding degree program or a bachelor-awarding degree program at Oklahoma Wesleyan University with maximum ease and without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution. The administrators of Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College are authorized to prepare and implement plans of actions and procedures necessary to affect this agreement. Both institutions agree to inform the other of curricular and policy changes on an annual basis, so the articulation agreement can remain current.

Duration. This agreement will be reviewed at the start of each academic year for the purpose of revision and renewal, if needed. This agreement can be changed at any time by mutual agreement, and, shall remain in effect until either institution notifies the other of termination or modification. This agreement supersedes all previous articulation agreements between these two institutions.

Disclaimers. No financial implications concerning the transfer of cash, equipment, or real estate is intended or implied by this agreement. Oklahoma Wesleyan University and Rhema Bible Training College are separate and independent institutions and intend to remain so. There are no third-party beneficiaries intended, contemplated, or created by the signing and execution of the terms of this agreement. Any provision in this agreement that is contrary to law or otherwise invalidated by any court shall not operate to invalidate any other provision of this agreement.

Articulation Agreement. Students from Rhema Bible Training College can apply academic credits earned at Rhema toward the degree requirements for an Associate's Degree or a Bachelor's Degree at Oklahoma Wesleyan University. Students from Rhema can also apply academic credits earned at Rhema as major courses requirements and applicable Bible Credits toward the Associate of Applied Science in Christian Ministry at Oklahoma Wesleyan University. This agreement is subject to the following institutional policies:

- No more than 30 credits may be applied toward an associate's degree.
- No more than 63 credits may be applied toward a bachelor's degree.

Students who have completed two courses in Old or New Testament at Rhema Bible
Training College may receive credit for one freshman level Old or New Testament course
at Oklahoma Wesleyan University. This credit is included in the 30 or 63 credit
maximum to be applied to an associate's or bachelor's degree, respectively.

Points of Clarification/Consideration. The acceptance of credits from Rhema Bible Training College to Oklahoma Wesleyan University is determinate upon the evaluation and approval of official transcripts by the Registrar at Oklahoma Wesleyan University. It is not time sensitive. This articulation agreement is built with the traditional and non-traditional learner in mind. Credits earned at Rhema Bible Training College, at the discretion of the appropriate dean, may be allowed to substitute for courses in major programs.
