Contact Student Health, or TimelyCare, or your physician.

Inform kwhite@okwu.edu

Follow your medical professional's recommendation.

Isolate if you have symptoms and while you are waiting on your test results. If test is positive - continue to isolate.

NEGATIVE:

Return to class when your symptoms are gone and you are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducting medicine.

Quarantine

Students in close contact with an infected person will quarantine for ten days. Students in quarantine will go to class with masks inside and outside the classroom and buildings, always keep hand sanitizer with them, and wash hands frequently. Students in quarantine will pick up to-go meals and eat in their rooms.

Isolation

For students in isolation, if no symptoms have occurred (asymptomatic) by day five, or if symptoms are resolving, including being fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine, the individual may move to quarantine protocols on day six. Will remain in quarantine until day 10.
